Enclose, with this entry form, copies of at least **two** testimonials/reports, one from your trainer, counter-signed by the vicar/minister/head teacher/director of music, confirming your good attendance at, and commitment to, the choir. The other should be from a tutor or director at a recent RSCM residential course, or a comparable activity. These copies will not be returned.

5 Deadline dates for entry, and notification of examination venue & date

*Your entry must arrive no later than **1 May** (for summer session) or **1 October** (for autumn session).*

Examinations may be held on *any weekday, daytime or early evening*, in the period 5-9 weeks after the entry deadline date. You undertake to make yourself available on the appointed date. A special arrangement can only be negotiated with RSCM Education in advance of submitting your entry.

Two weeks before each entry date, candidates in England & Wales will have the opportunity to select a convenient venue and date, from a list available from RSCM Education and on the RSCM website. *Appointments cannot be guaranteed*, and are dependent upon at least 3 Gold Award candidates indicating they are available on any the date shown and at that venue. *Trainers with 3+ candidates at one session, please contact us, in advance, to arrange a special visit to you.* Candidates in Ireland and Scotland should contact their RSCM Co-ordinator, in advance, for discussion of a possible venue.
