## **MILLENNIUM YOUTH CHOIR PERFORMS IN SALISBURY**

**The Royal School of Church Music's Millennium Youth Choir will give two concerts in Salisbury during its Easter Course in April.**

The choir, conducted by David Ogden and accompanied by organist Daniel Moulton, will give two concerts during their stay. The first is a free lunchtime concert at Salisbury Cathedral on Wednesday 9th April at 1.05pm, finishing at 1.45pm.

The second will be held at the parish church of Sarum St Martin, the oldest building in Salisbury, on Friday 11th April at 7.30pm. Tickets for this concert are available in advance from the Salisbury Playhouse box office on 01722 320333, or on the door on the night, and are £10 for adults, £5 under 18s. The programme will feature a wide range of choral music including excerpts from Roxanna Panufnik's *Westminster Mass*.

The choir was formed in 1999 at the suggestion of the former Archbishop of Canterbury, George Carey, and is made up of some of the finest young church singers drawn from church and university choirs all over the UK and has appeared many times on BBC radio and television.

Working with the celebrated composer John Rutter, the RSCM Millennium Youth Choir recorded a CD in 2007, and in the summer they will travel to Belgium and Holland to record a broadcast of Choral Evensong for BBC Radio 3 and take part in concerts and services.
