

GIFT AID

Gift Aid provides a great opportunity for us to increase the value of your donations to the RSCM.

If you are a UK taxpayer and complete the gift aid declaration below, we can claim back the tax on your Friend subscription and on any extra donation you make to us.

For example, if you give £10 using Gift Aid, that donation is worth £12.50 to us because we can claim an extra £2.50 from the Inland Revenue.

Notes:

- 1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the RSCM.
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the RSCM reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1 you give).
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the RSCM reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, please ask the RSCM or your local tax office for advice.
6. Please notify the RSCM if you change your name or address.
