

30. You're my friend

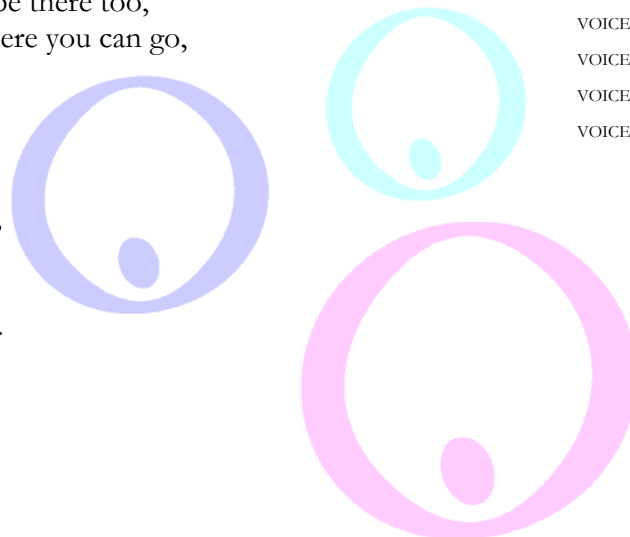
