### RSCM Music Sunday

Churches are encouraged to take part in RSCM Music Sunday, combining a celebration of the role of music in worship with fundraising. The 50:50 campaign enables churches to raise funds for themselves and for the RSCM on a 50:50 basis.

In 2016 RSCM Music Sunday takes place on or near 12 June, to coincide with The Patron's Lunch, a celebration of Her Majesty the Queen's 90th birthday. In some places a different date may be chosen to pursue the theme and related fundraising activities.

During this period of Ordinary Time churches may choose to depart from the lectionary and the following readings are suggested for a Music Sunday celebration. (NB for a service of Holy Communion, a Gospel reading must be included.)
